A big driving day.

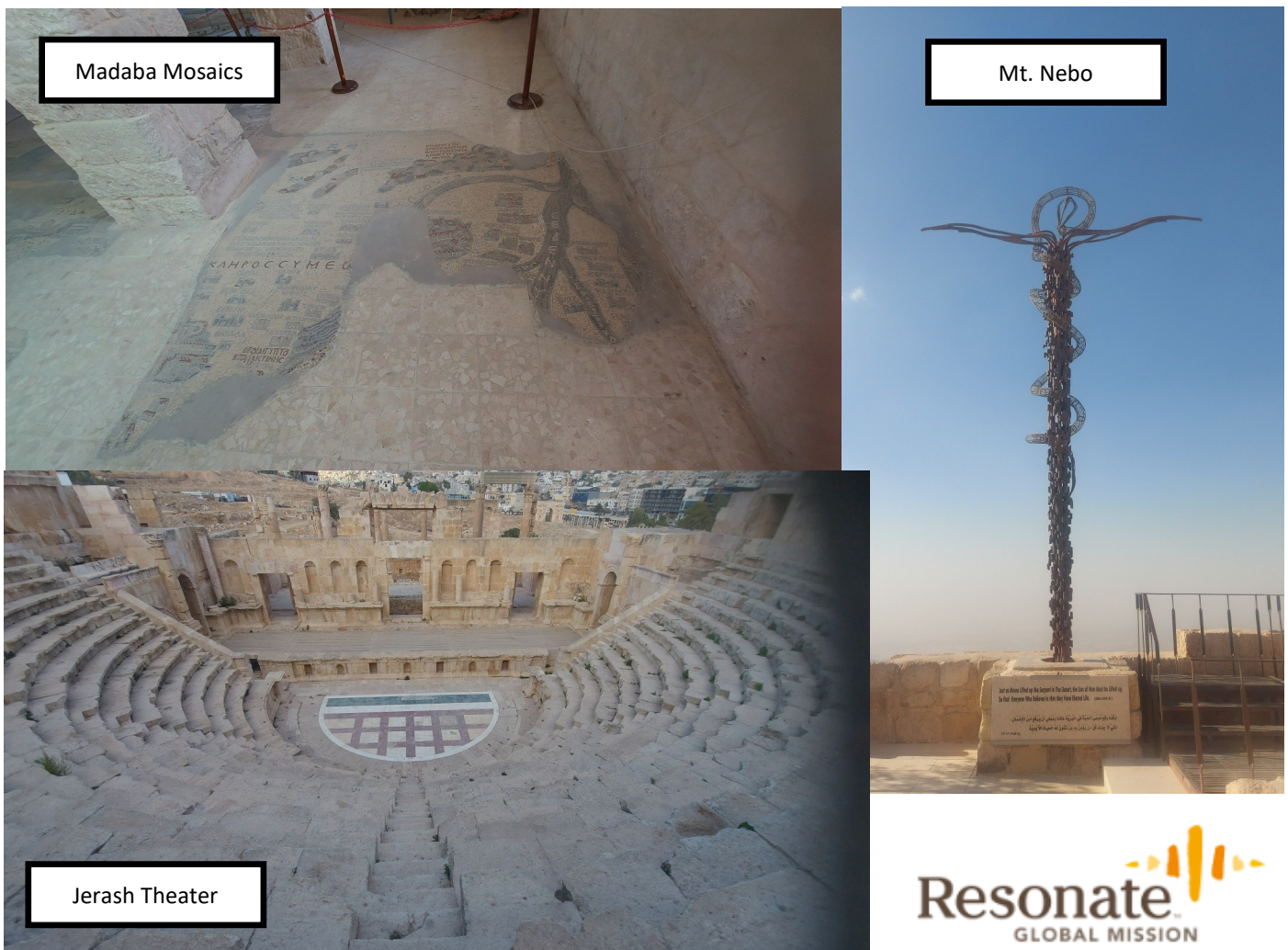
Jerash: an amazing Greco-Roman city, part of the Biblical Gadarenes and Decapolis.

Drive to Petra for hotel evening.



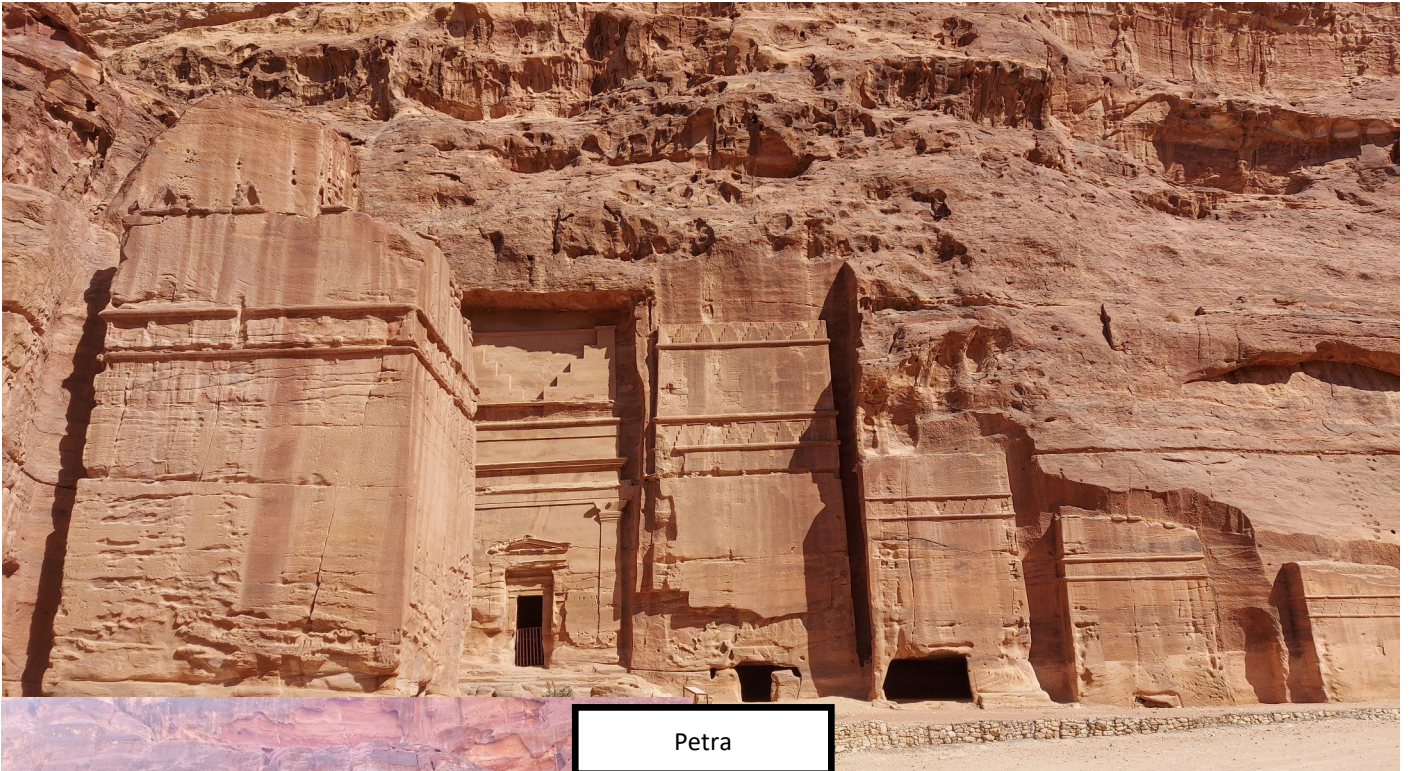
DAY 4 - PETRA

A big walking day.

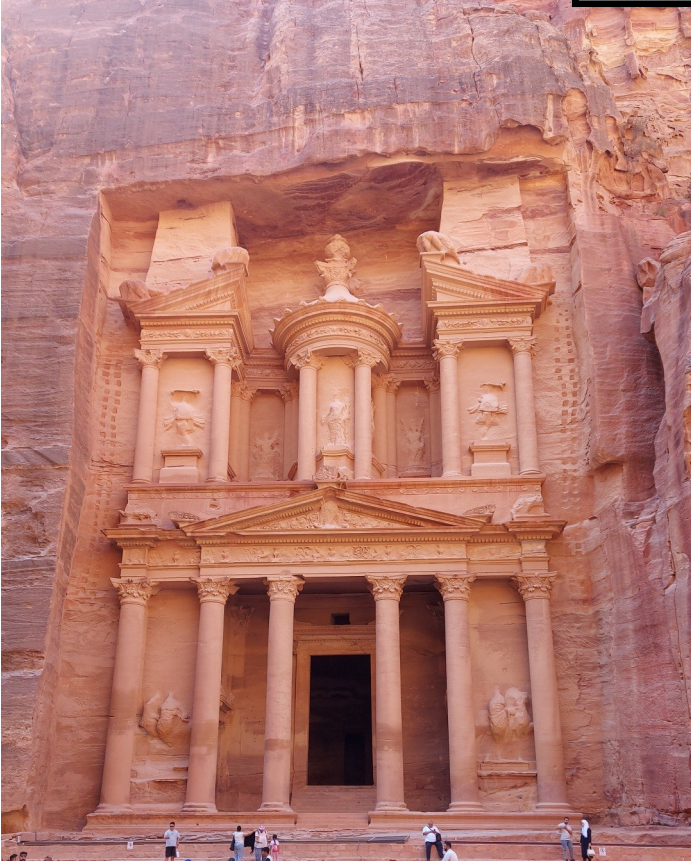
We will ride in electric vehicles to the famous Treasury then walk our way through Petra.

Evening flight to Aswan.



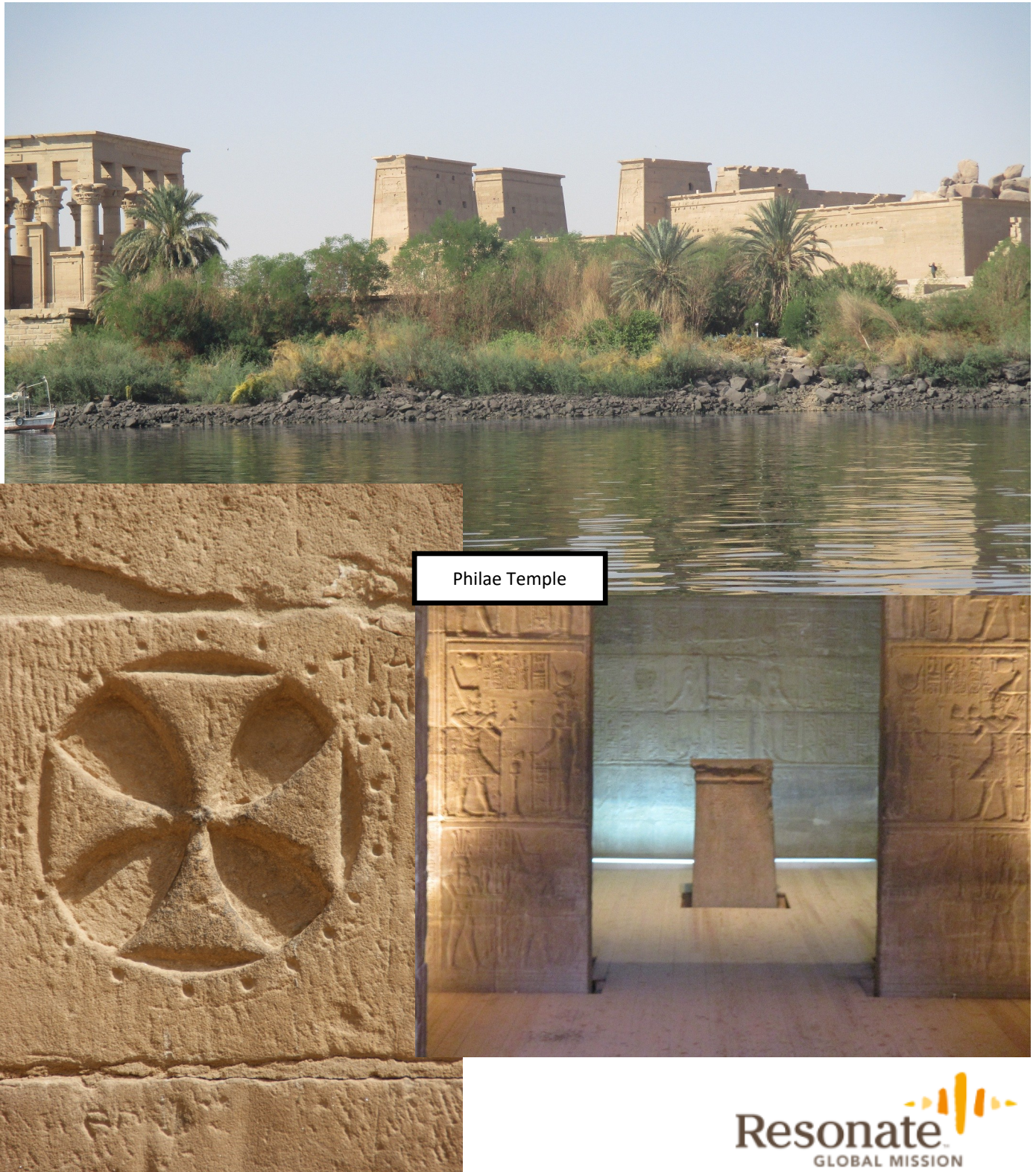
DAY 7 - ASWAN-PHILAE TEMPLE-UNFINISHED OBELISK -NUBIAN MUSEUM

Hotel:

Philae Temple: A well preserved temple that was moved out of the waters of the dammed Nile river.

Unfinished obelisk: 1200 tons of solid granite that cracked while removing it from the granite cliffs.

Nubian Museum: See influence of Nubia (modern Sudan) on upper Egypt.

Worker village: artisans for the Valley of the Kings lived here

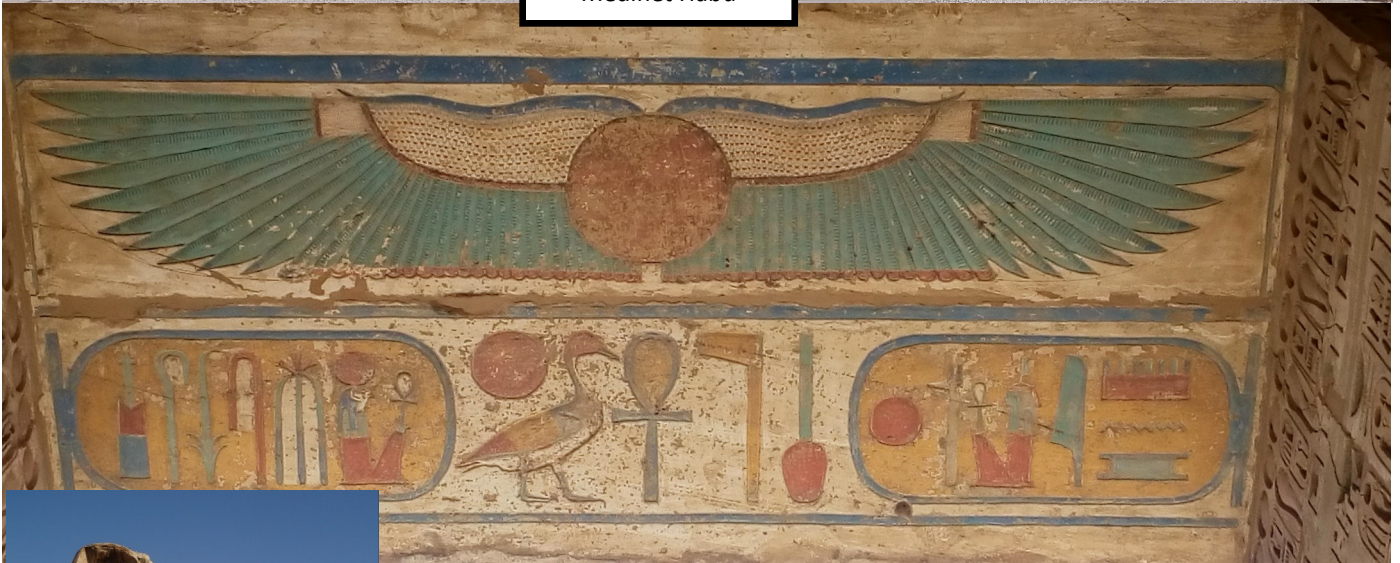


DAY 11 - LUXOR WEST BANK 2

DAY 12 - LUXOR EAST BANK

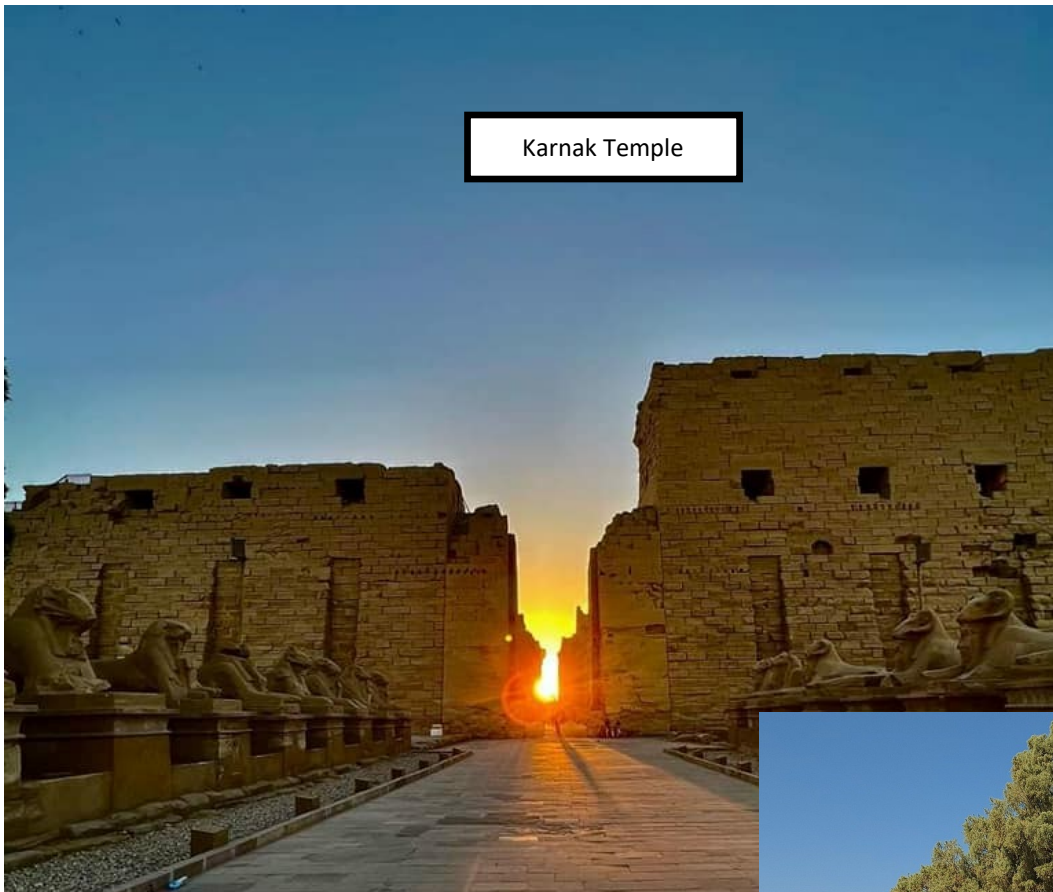
From the cruise boat to Hotel in Cairo

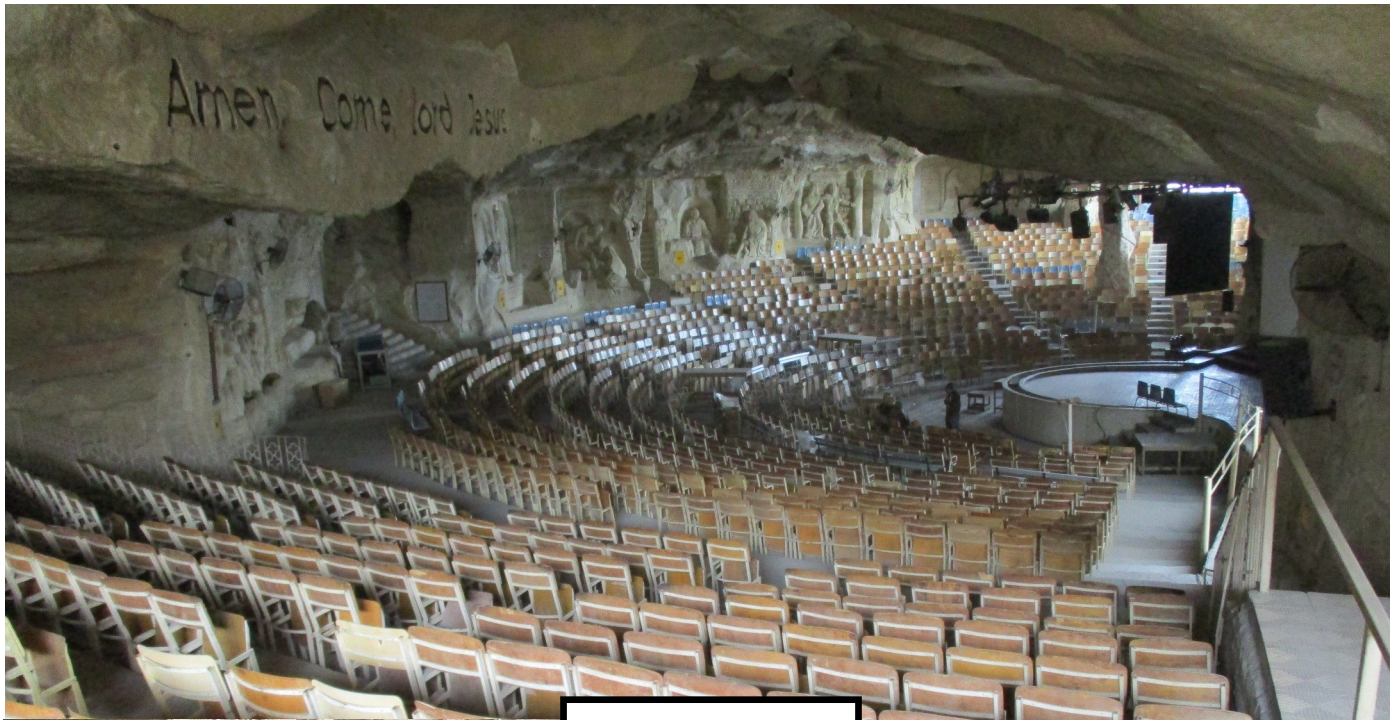
DAY 13 - GARBAGE VILLAGE-CAVE CHURCHES-APE

St. Simeon Cave Church

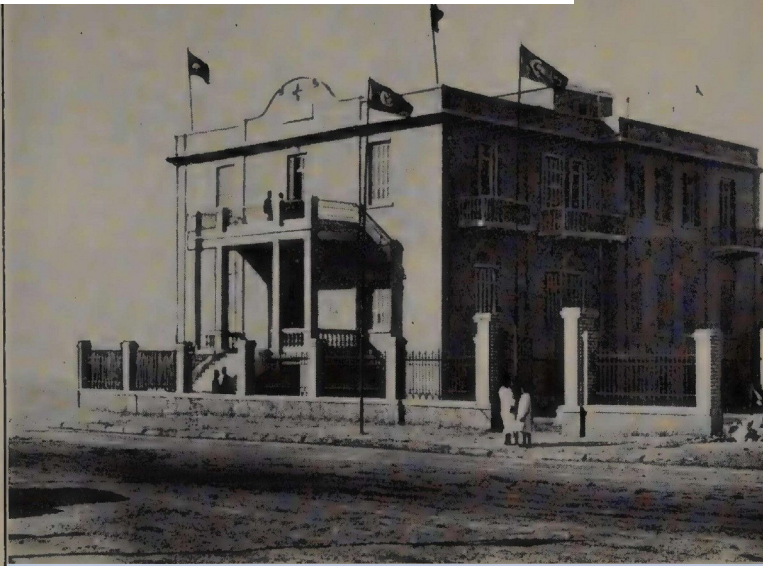


DAY 14 - MINISTRY DAY
