

PRAYING ON MISSION: A 12-WEEK JOURNEY

Engaging People. Embracing Christ.

INTRODUCTION

The importance of prayer in Local Mission is often overlooked or minimized, but truthfully it must be the foundation that leads us to love our neighbors and share the gospel in our communities. The study of Christian Reformed churches who grew through evangelism in 2023 revealed that prayer was one of the common themes. Pastors made comments such as, "We struggle with evangelism if 'we lack a heart of prayer saturation'"; "This is a season of new fire, new energy. It stems from sitting in God's presence."; and "One common denominator is that God was working in their hearts before we even met them."

This 12-week missional prayer guide provides a series of prayers to be used within congregational worship as a means of saturating your strategy for local mission with prayer. The prayers begin with seeking God to work in our own hearts, followed by asking God to work in our community, ending with asking God how mission will work through us in our community. Each prayer time is contextualized, including sentence starters for personal listening and intercession. You can encourage your congregation to continue these prayers throughout the week with the one-page handouts that mirror the congregational prayers.

May God hear the prayers of his people and show his power as we humbly seek God's face.

These prayers can be used in multiple settings:

Congregational Prayers - If this is being used in a congregational prayer setting, the person can pick one or two prayer prompts and leave silence afterward.

Small Groups - If this is in a small group setting, reading the prayer and then giving the prompts and asking people to pray them together would be ideal. The leader can use one or all of them.

Individual Prayer - Have participants read the prayer and then pray through each of the prompts. The prompts are to help begin and direct the prayer time, not to the only things to pray.



Prayers for ourselves that we would be transformed into the likeness of Jesus

COLOSSIANS 3:12-17

Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Thank you, Spirit, that you dwell in us richly as you transform us into the likeness of Jesus, leading and guiding our lives.

Through Christ, you change our lives from the old self to the new self.

from conforming to this world to reflecting the character of God.

Through your word, through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, you shape us.

Thank you for making us into the likeness of the Son.

Work in us so that we have abundant grace toward others, forgiving one another as you have forgiven us.

Work in us so we reflect your character to our family, our neighbors, our coworkers, and those in our church.

We pray that we would be transformed and renewed so that through our words and deeds, we would be a witness to those around us of you and your incredible love.

2 CORINTHIANS 3:17-18

Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

EPHESIANS 2:8-10

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

PRAISE

We can do this because, God, we know you are good, we know you long to bless us, we know you long to have us grow in our relationship with you, and have us see your glory. Prayer for Spiritual Warfare

EPHESIANS 6:13-20

Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people. Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.

Equip us to fight the good fight and resist the enemy, not on our own strength, but through your Word, through your Spirit, and through prayer. Help us to do this in community with one another, not thinking we can do it alone.

We pray against the spiritual conflicts in our neighborhoods, in our churches, in our own lives. We pray that through the power of the Holy Spirit, you would bring freedom to those captive to sin, release for the prisoners of darkness, so that we might live in the life of the Son.

Open to the Unexpected Moving of the Holy Spirit

ISAIAH 43:18-19

"Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland.

ACTS 16:6-10

Paul and his companions traveled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been kept by the Holy Spirit from preaching the word in the province of Asia. When they came to the border of Mysia, they tried to enter Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus would not allow them to. So they passed by Mysia and went down to Troas. During the night Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him, "Come over to Macedonia and help us." After Paul had seen the vision, we got ready at once to leave for Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them.

Praying for the Brokenness in our Community

2 CORINTHIANS 5:18-21

All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. God made him who had no sin to be sin! for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

PRAISE

Father, we praise you because you did not abandon us in the garden when we disobeyed and turned against you. In your compassion, you sought us out. In your mercy, you showed us grace.

Father, we praise you for sending your son, Jesus, to live among us as the presence of God. And that through Jesus you made a way for us to settle our relationship with you and our relationships with each other. You gave us a fresh start by offering forgiveness of sins.

And now, Father, we stand humbly before you, as people who do not deserve to be in your presence but have been reconciled with you through Christ. We give you all the glory and praise.

LUKE 4:18-19

PRAISE

Prayers for Being Sent

ACTS 1:8

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

ACTS 13:1-5

Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen (who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch) and Saul. While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off. The two of them, sent on their way by the Holy Spirit, went down to Seleucia and sailed from there to Cyprus. Prayer for Fruitfulness in the Work of the Gospel

COLOSSIANS 4:2-6

Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should. Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.
