Exodus Vision Trip

April 14: Leave Home Airport

April 15: Arrive Cairo

You will be picked up by bus and taken to your room for the night for an evening of getting to know each other and resting for the big trip ahead.

April 16: Saqqara and Giza

We will walk where Abraham, Jacob, Joseph, and Moses walked. The oldest and first pyramids of Saqqara and the Great Pyramids of Giza, they were thousands of years old already when the Children of Israel were in Egypt. In the evening we will fly to Luxor and check into our Bed and Breakfast there.

April 17: Luxor West Bank

On the West Bank of Luxor we will see the Valley of the Kings, discuss which may have been the Pharaoh of the Exodus. See Habu and Ramses Temple's and visit the Worker Village where there is evidence of Israel there.

April 18: Luxor East Bank

We will cross back over the Nile river to visit the biggest of Temples: Karnak where we will see evidence of Israel and learn about the purpose of the temples. Then to Luxor Museum, probably the best in Egypt and end at Luxor temple and the avenue of the Sphinx. In late afternoon we will fly to Sharm el Sheikh for the night.

April 19: Mount Sinai

In the morning we will drive from Sharm to Mt. Sinai. You will have the chance to climb the mountain and look over the valley where most believe Israel camped while Moses spoke with God on the mountain. Along the way you can stop at Elijah's lookout where God spoke in a still small voice. After we will ferry to Aqaba, Jordan were we will get a hotel for the night.

April 20: Petra

From Aqaba we will drive to Petra. Depending on our timing we will explore some of Petra, where King Herod's family came from and the ancient site of Edom (Esau's family).

April 21: Dead Sea, Lot's cave

We will visit Petra again in the morning to get at the sites we may not have gotten to

last night. Then we drive to our hotel at the Dead Sea, stopping at Lot's cave along the way. We will check into our Dead Sea spa and float on the Salt Lake.

April 22 Mt. Nebo, Jordan Baptism site, Makawir Fortress

From the Dead Sea we will drive north to Mt. Nebo where Moses saw the whole of the land and God buried him. Then to the Jordanian Baptism site (the most likely one) and Makawir Fortress where Herod is said to have imprisoned and killed John the Baptist.

April 23: Sea of Galilee, Capernaum

A long day of driving north to the Sea of Galilee and Um Qais where we will cross the Sheikh Hussein bridge into Israel and hotel at the Sea of Galilee. We will

April 24: Nazareth, Cana, Mt. Tabor

Today we visit Nazareth, the home of Jesus and where he spent his early years. Then to close by Cana where he performed his first miracle of water into wine. Finally to Mt. Tabor where Balaam was to curse the Israelites but ended up blessing them and where many believe Christ's transfiguration occurred.

April 25: Caesarea, Megiddo

Today will be another day of driving with two stops. The first will be Caesarea which was home to Herod the Great on the Mediterranean Sea. Then on to Megiddo where many battles have been fought and there is a fortress built by David and Solomon. We will continue our drive and hotel in Jerusalem.

April 26: Old City Jerusalem

Finally we will walk through the old city of Jerusalem, starting at Bethany and entering through the New Gate into the city. We will walk through the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, the Wailing Wall and Dome of the Rock

April 27: Bethlehem, Jericho, Masada

We will cross into the West Bank of Palestine and visit the birthplace of Jesus in Bethlehem, then we join our Exodus again with a trip to Jericho, finally we will end at the great fortress of Masada. Back to Jerusalem for the night/

April 28: Tel Aviv

Today is our drive to Tel Aviv to catch your evening flight home, or hotel for the night to catch your early morning flight home.
